SUMMARY OF DUTIES:

Responsible for all professional nursing duties as required. Provides supervision to other nursing staff, including licensed practical nurses and any on-call or part-time registered nurses. Enforces policies and procedures regarding storage, dispensing, and inventory of medication, monitoring and promoting the physical health and well-being of the women and children in the residence. Assists residents with developing holistic health care plans for themselves and their children, and ensures that they are linked to indicate health care providers. Teaches residents about pregnancy, fetal development, AIDS, STD's, etc. in a variety of modalities. Monitors compliance with regulatory and program policies about HIV/AIDS and other communicable diseases. In conjunction with physician/consultants, establishes infection control procedures and protocols. Performs other duties as assigned by supervisory staff.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES:

Must have strong knowledge of nursing functions, including holistic assessment and goal development. Knowledge of family medicine, and perinatal and pediatric health issues required. Must be knowledgeable about communicable disease transmission. Must have strong interpersonal skills and be able to relate to clients individually and in groups. Demonstrated ability to establish positive relationships with women from diverse cultures is required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Graduation from an accredited school of professional nursing, AND a license to practice as a registered professional nurse in New York State or possession of a temporary permit, AND four years of experience, at least three of which must have been in a mental health, substance abuse treatment, or perinatal health care setting.

AND

Must have a NYS driver's license. May be required to participate as member of on-call team.
